The graduates appreciate your viewing and thank you for your prayers, support, and encouragement during their time at Ethnos360 Bible Institute.



For their class project, the senior class of 2020 has been privileged and honored to financially support, pray for, and encourage Jordan and Jessica Martin, recent graduates of Ethnos 360 Bible Institute, Waukesha.

After the Martins finished their culture and linguistic studies, the Lord led them, with their five sons, to Puvirnituq, Quebec, a community of 1700 people. The Inuit people live in fear and confusion and are captive to animism and syncretism. Drug and alcohol abuse are rampant, and child sex trafficking is not uncommon. Jordan shared that the people's response to the gospel is "cautious, reserved and apprehensive". The darkness is both physical and spiritual.

Since the community is remote and isolated, the only access is by plane. Literally everything must be flown in (all supplies, health, schooling, food etc.) which is very costly. This is where the senior class desired to give a helping hand. They organized many activities such as bake sales, auctions, president for a day, and just plain generous giving to raise a total of \$3000+. Sadly, their fund raising was cut short due to Covid19, but they are thrilled that they had a small part in tundra evangelism.

The Martins had to leave their mission station due to the Covid19 pandemic, but are so anxious to return. Please pray that they would be able to return soon and that the Lord's love will spread across that region as more people become interested in this very neglected field. "We thought it would be super neat if we could be a part of individuals working on the mission field as we prayed for them, stayed in contact through updates and emails, and ask how we could bless them financially." —Reece Field"And the things that you have heard from me among many witnesses, commit these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also."
