



EBI “Christian Merit and Ministry Partners” Scholarship Application

The EBI “Christian Merit and Ministry Partners” Scholarship is established and funded by Ethnos360 Bible Institute (EBI) to encourage those associated with ministry partners of EBI to consider enrolling in EBI for Biblical training for ministry.

Scholarships are applied for prior to freshman semester. Maximum limit on scholarships awarded is \$1,000 disbursed in freshman semester (\$500) and junior semester (\$500) (junior award is subject to a minimum GPA of 3.0 for freshman and sophomore semesters).

Applicants can only apply for and receive one EBI scholarship. Married students are also limited to receiving one EBI scholarship, even if both qualify individually.

If applying for an EBI scholarship for any other organization or church, please include info on the organization (if any), dates and place of service, and ministry performed. A staff or pastoral recommendation may be requested.

Scholarship applications must be received by **August 1**, prior to the start of your freshman semester. Submit applications, with the appropriate documentation, electronically or by mail to 835 N Hartwell Ave., Waukesha, WI 53186. Scholarships are awarded based on availability of scholarship funds. Overall quality of scholarship submission is considered.
