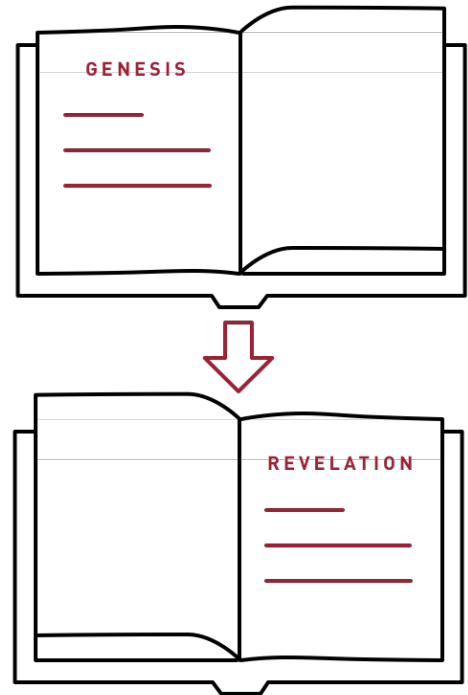
Dig Deep into God's Word

A deep understanding of the Bible is essential for missions and a life of ministry. By investing two years into God's Word, you can feel confident about what the Bible says and be equipped for wherever God takes you next.

Study the Whole Bible in Order, from Genesis to Revelation

It can be really confusing to open up a book and start reading in the middle. To fully understand a story and its characters, you start at chapter one and go from there.

Over your two years here, you will study through the Bible from the first book, Genesis, all the way to the final book, Revelation. Studying through the Bible chronologically will give you a clear understanding of God's story.

Missionary Training with Ethnos360

Founded in 1942, Ethnos360 exists to plant thriving churches among unreached people groups. This means missions is at the core of who we are, and Ethnos360 Bible Institute is the perfect first step for working cross-culturally. No matter where the Lord leads in the future, you will be prepared to further the reach of the gospel.



Learn from Staff with Cross-Cultural Experience

Our staff here are missionaries with Ethnos360, and many of them have cross-cultural experience. You will hear their heart for the nations both inside and outside of the classroom.

Discover God's Heart on a Short-Term Trip

Learn how God can use you to further the reach of the gospel. Our short-term trips are centered around unreached people groups and designed to help you experience the global need.



Wayumi is a week-long course in Pennsylvania where you will learn and experience the unique challenges and facets of cross-cultural ministry among the unreached people groups of the world.



Spend two weeks learning, serving, and experiencing ministry among unreached people groups. You will see mission field realities first hand and learn what it takes to bring the gospel to the very ends of the earth.



Interface is a college-level missions course across the globe. Spend three months in Papua New Guinea studying through the Bible, learning a new language and culture, and experiencing cross-cultural missions.

Graduate Unhindered by Debt and Student Loans

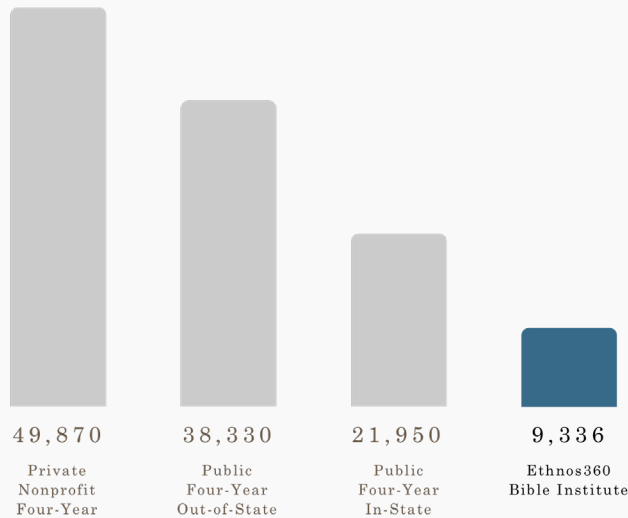
Most of our students are heading to the mission field and a life of ministry, so we don't want to add any lingering financial baggage. Our aim is to help you graduate debt-free so you can take your next step with God.

Affordable for a Reason - Your Future Ministry

Ethnos360 Bible Institute costs \$9,336 per year for a single student.

This includes your tuition, housing, meals, accident insurance, fees, and books.

For our married students, the cost per year for a couple is \$10,092. This includes tuition, housing, student accident insurance, fees, and books.
